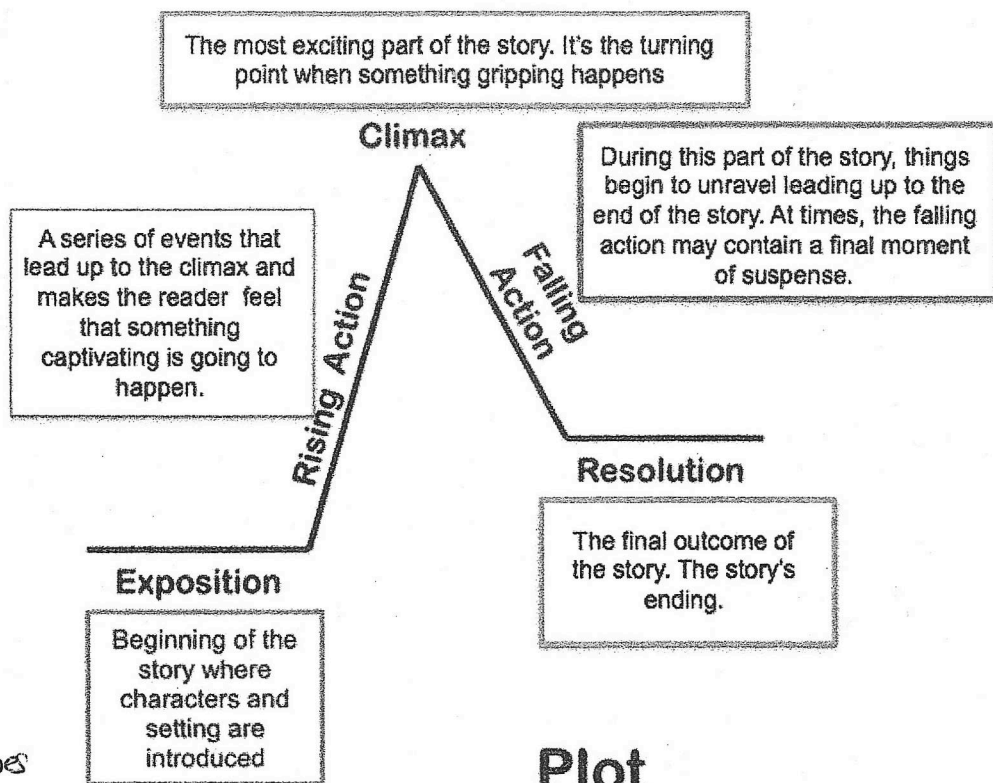

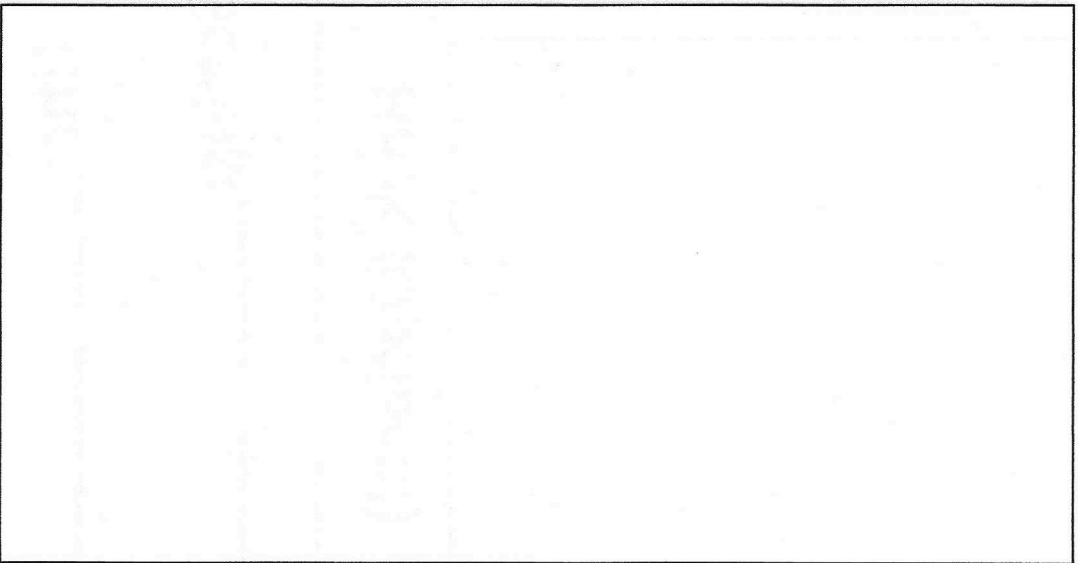

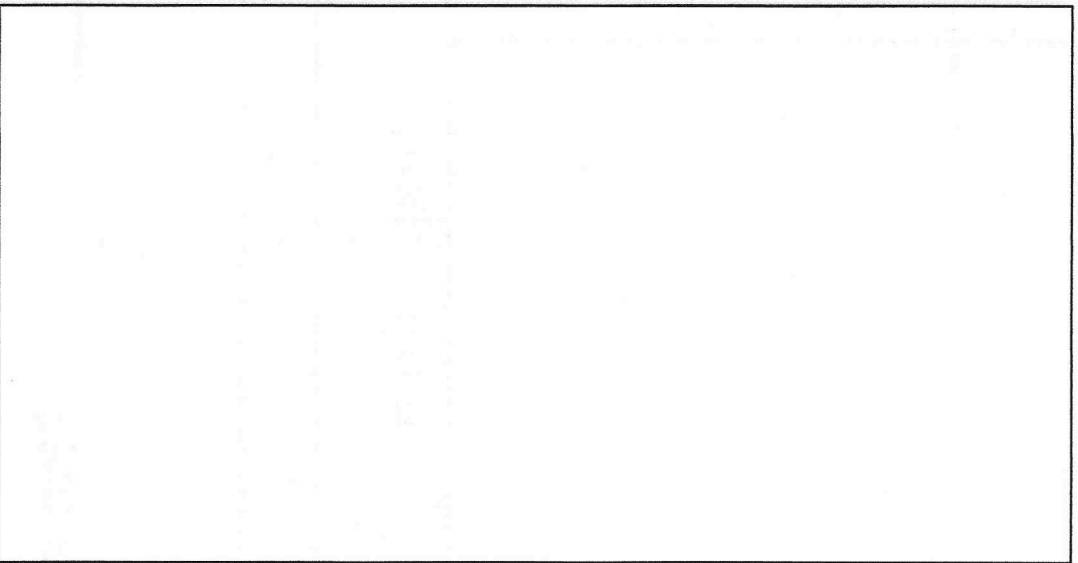
Rising Action

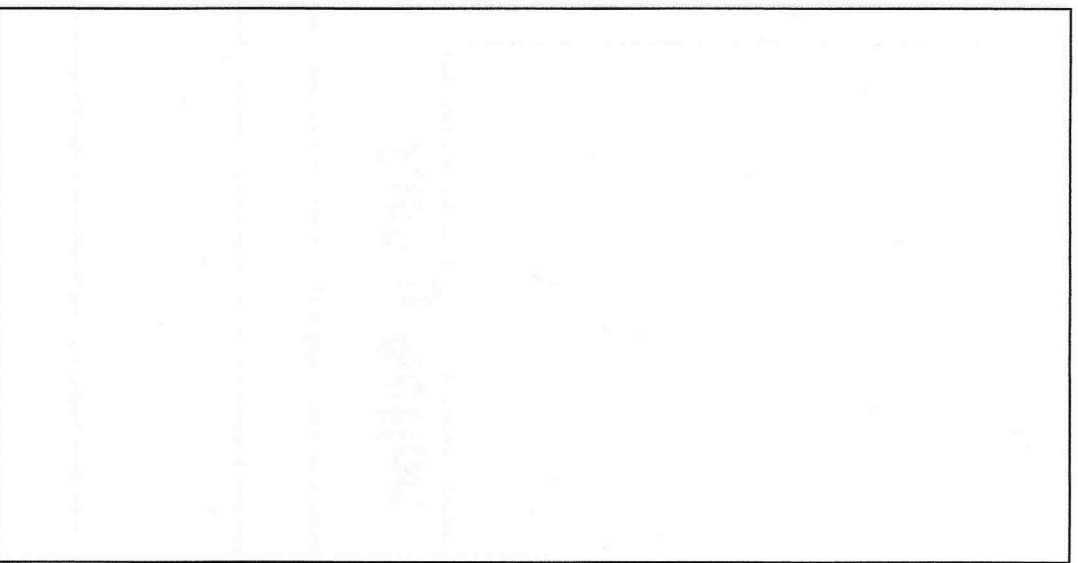
Climax
